A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A VARIANCE FROM THE U.S. HIGHWAY 80 OVERLAY DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a hearing was held before the Board of Zoning Appeals wherein applicant, Robert Teasley, requested a variance from the U.S. Highway 80 Overlay District for single businesses signage to increase sign height from 6 feet allowed to 20 feet, request a variance to increase area from 36 square feet allowed to 100 square feet, and request a variance to construct a pylon sign (ordinance requires a monument style sign) for a new Joe Hudson’s Collision Center, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Zoning Appeals denied this request for variance on January 2, 2019 and applicant appeals this decision to the Columbus Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
